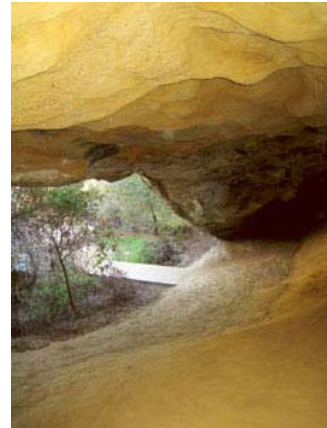


PLEASE COME ALONG ON THE ANNUAL

At Aliso and Wood Canyons Wilderness Park

This is a real hike of about 5 miles round trip but it is all flat. Each Den will also make a short report on the trip to share at the next meeting.
